

Where you elect to use IPFS storage in Nexum Hub any personal information and supporting documents (your “Individual User Data”) that you provide to Nexum Hub will be stored in a hybrid centralised and decentralised manner. A portion of your Individual User Data (the “Public Component”) will be stored in a decentralised storage medium (Interplanetary File System or “IPFS”). None of your underlying personal information can be read from the Public Component in isolation. The Public Component is also protected by multiple layers of encryption.

As the Public Component will be stored on a decentralised storage medium it may be stored on a node in a jurisdiction that has less stringent data protection regulations than those enforced in the United Kingdom or the EEA. You expressly acknowledge that you provide Nexum with your consent to store your Individual User Data using the Nexum Hub storage mechanism, including the potential transfer of the Public Component of your Individual User Data to a decentralised storage medium.

This consent is provided in respect of Article 7 of the EU General Data Protection Regulation. As required by this Article, you will be able to withdraw this consent at any time within your account settings in which case the Public Component will instead be stored in Nexum Hub’s centralised storage.
