Section I. Privacy Policy Overview

This privacy policy ("Privacy Policy" or "Policy") describes how NEXM INC., NEXUM HUB INC. and NEXUM LENDING LIMITED (each a "Company" and together the "Companies" or "us" or "we" or "our") collects, stores, and uses personal information about you when you visit our website at nexum.app, nexum.finance and nexum.ai (the "Site"), our social media account on Twitter @CoinNexum, our Telegram channels nexum_offical and CoinNexum, our Discord account Nexum Official, and our YouTube channel Nexum Platform, use our mobile application or other media platforms, purchase our products, or use services supplied by or on behalf of us (collectively, "Services"). In this Privacy Policy, "you" means any person who visits our Site, uses our Services, emails, texts, or calls us on the phone. This Privacy Policy is provided to explain how information, including personal information, is collected, stored, used, and disclosed.

All updates to this Privacy Policy are published at the top of this page, with a time-date reference for your convenience. Each Company reserves the right in its sole discretion to amend this Privacy Policy at any time. Your continued use of the Services and the Site after we make changes is deemed to be acceptance of those changes, so please check the Privacy Policy periodically for updates. This Privacy Policy applies to all our other websites that post this Privacy Policy. This Policy does not address the privacy, information collection, use, disclosure and/or retention practices of any third-party entities. Please review any applicable third-party entity's privacy policy for more information regarding such third-party entity's own privacy or information practices. No Company has any liability with respect to the use or misuse of personal information by such third-party entities or any failure to comply with such third-party entities' privacy policies. If you choose to use our Site or Services, your use and any dispute over privacy is subject to this Privacy Policy and our Terms of Use, including limitations on damages, resolution of disputes and application of the law of England and Wales. By accessing our Site or using our Services, you confirm that you have read and accepted the terms of this Privacy Policy.

Section II. Consent

By accessing, browsing, or otherwise using the Site or our Services, you expressly consent to our collection, storage, use, and disclosure of your information, including personal information, as described in this Privacy Policy and any related terms of service relevant to our Services. Please read this Privacy Policy and the related terms of service carefully to understand our practices and your options. If you do not agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy, you must not use our Site or our Services.

Section III. Privacy of Children

Our Site and Services are not intended for children. You must be at least eighteen (18) years of age to use the Site and/or Services related to the Site. If we learn or have reason to suspect that a user is under age eighteen (18), we will promptly delete any personal information in that user's account.

Section IV. What is Personal Information?

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy and compliance with applicable law and EU General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR"), and in accordance with applicable law and GDPR, personal information (or personal data) relating to an identified or identifiable person, or which identifies, relates to, describes, is reasonably capable of being associated with, or could be linked, directly, or indirectly, with a particular individual or household. Personal information does not include publicly available information.

Section V. Categories of Information We Collect

We collect the information you give us when you contact us, access the Site, opt-in to receive alerts or other information from us via email, text, or instant message, or use our Services. We collect your personal information for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy. The information we collect includes:

- Identifiers and contact information, such as your name, address, phone number, email address, or social media IDs:
- Purchase or other commercial information, such as specific activities like digital asset lending
 and borrowing transactions, as well as your home or billing address, and contact information (such
 as for receipts or order updates);
- Payment information, such as your digital wallet information, payment method and payment
 information (such as debit or credit card number and information), and billing address. We also store
 your public key if you have linked a digital wallet to your account or have provided the same to us;
- **Preference information**, such as your contact and marketing preferences, interests, opinions, and brand and merchandise interests;
- **Profile and account information**, which may include contact, purchase, and preference information as well as your account password and other information about your profile or account;
- **Communications and interactions**, which may include feedback, comments, testimonials, reviews, email messages, chat sessions, text messages, and phone calls that we exchange with you;
- **Demographic information**, which may include age or birthdate, gender, ZIP code, and other information about you;

- **Customer surveys**, we may periodically conduct both business and individual customer surveys. Your personal information and responses will remain strictly confidential, even if the survey is conducted by a third party. Participation in our customer surveys is voluntary;
- Call recordings, including information about your call and that you share when you call us on the phone;
- Location or geolocation information of your device that you use to access our Site, if your device settings allow us to collect location information;
- Device and browsing information and other Internet activity information, including information about your phone, tablet, computer, or device, and online browsing activity (collectively, "automatically collected information"). Automatically collected information may include IP addresses, unique device identifiers, cookie identifiers, device and browser settings and information, and Internet Service Provider information. Automatically collected information also may include information about when and how you access and use our Site, such as the date and time of your visit or use, the websites you visit before coming and after leaving our Site, how you navigate and what you search for using our Site, the Site pages and items you view using our Site, and the items you purchase; and
- **Inferences** about any of the information above that may relate to your preferences, or other matters. We may collect analytics data, or use third-party analytics tools, to help us measure traffic and usage trends and to learn more about the demographics of our users.

If you do not provide us with your personal data, you may not be able to register for an account and some features of the Site may be unavailable to you.

Section VI. How We Collect Information (Sources)

We collect information on our Site and during calls and communications with you. We also obtain information from you and from third parties. For example, we collect and obtain information:

- When you engage in a transaction with us or interact with a representative of any Company, including but not limited to making a purchase, interacting with a salesperson, visiting or contacting us, registering for an online account, participating in a contest or sweepstakes, responding to a survey, engaging in a promotional activity, applying for employment, or signing up for emails or marketing;
- From Wi-Fi and mobile devices, such as information about your device when you use our Site or Services;
- From third parties, such as service providers that we use, analytics companies, advertising networks and cooperatives, demographic companies, third parties that provide us with information about you and the different devices you use online, and other third parties that we choose to collaborate or work with;

- From social media platforms and networks that you use in connection with our Site or mobile application, or that share or allow you to share information with us, such as Facebook, Twitter, Pinterest, and Instagram. For example, if you use functionalities, plugins, widgets, or tools from social media platforms or networks in connection with our Site (e.g., to log into an account, or to share inspiration, finds, purchases, and other content with your friends and followers on social media), we will collect the information that you share with us, or that those social media platforms or networks share with us. - Using cookies and automatic collection methods. For example, we and third parties we work

 - o Cookies (which may be session-based or persistent, and are typically small data files that are stored on your hard drive or in connection with your Internet browser);
 - o Web beacons or tags(small images embedded into websites or emails that send information about your computer, tablet, phone, or other device when you visit our website, use or mobile application, or open an email we send to you);
 - o Website and mobile application log files (which we tend to create automatically in connection with access to and use of our website and mobile application);
 - o Flash cookies or Local Stored Objects (which may be placed using Adobe Flash software); and
 - o Other technologies (which may be similar to or different than the methods noted above).

Cookies are used to help us understand your preferences for future visits based on previous or current Site activity. We also use cookies to compile aggregate data about Site traffic and Site interaction so that we can offer better Site experiences, tools and Services in the future. You may choose to have your computer warn you each time a cookie is being sent. Your browser can also be set to block cookies, but some features of the Site or our Services may not properly work if you do this. You can make these changes in your browser settings, however, since each browser is a little different, look at your browser's "Help Menu" to learn the correct way to modify your cookies settings.

Section VII. How We Use Information

We use the information that we collect to conduct our business and to provide you with the best possible products, services and experiences. We also may combine any or all of the information that we collect or obtain. Examples of how we use information include:

- To provide you with products and services, such as to: fulfil your service orders and process your payments; process, maintain and service your account(s); and to provide you with products and services that we think you will like;
- To respond to you, such as when you: place a service order; call us; make a request or inquiry; complete a survey; or share a comment or concern;
- For personalization of your experiences with us, including to: remember your interests and preferences; customize the products and services we share with you; facilitate your interactions with our representatives; track and categorize your activity and interests on our Site, including by identifying the different devices you use; and to enrich your experience on our Site;
- For marketing and advertising, such as to: send you marketing and advertising communications, and to customize the marketing and advertising that we show you (we offer choices about marketing and advertising as noted in the Your Choices section below);
- For analytics, such as to: understand how you use our Site and our Services; determine the methods and devices used to access our Site; troubleshoot technical difficulties and errors; and improve Site functionality;
- For our business purposes, such as: to operate and improve upon our business and lawful business activities; to maintain our programs, accounts, and records; for research; to determine your satisfaction with our products and Services; to detect and prevent fraud or misuse of our Services; and for any other business purpose that is permitted by law; or
- For legal and safety purposes, such as to: defend or protect us, our customers, you, or third
 parties, from harm or in legal proceedings; protect our rights; protect our security and the security
 of our customers, employees, and property; respond to court orders, lawsuits, subpoenas, and
 government requests; address legal and regulatory compliance; respond to an emergency; and
 notify you of product recalls or safety.

Section VIII. Whom We Share Information With

Except as disclosed in this Privacy Policy, we do not share your personal information with any parties other than the other Companies, its parents, affiliates, subsidiaries or related entities, and in no event will we ever sell or rent your personal information. We may share personal information with third parties for other purposes. For example, we may share personal information with:

- Our family of brands and companies, owned or controlled by us, including our affiliates, parents, and subsidiaries;
- Third parties and service providers that provide products or services to us, that help us market
 or advertise to you (including co-branded marketing and advertising), or that provide services to
 you on our behalf. We may use third parties or service providers to help with managing our
 relationship with you, auditing interactions and transactions with you, processing your payments,

to us or on our behalf, addressing security, fixing errors, helping us with advertising or marketing, maintaining accounts and providing customer service, helping with our internal research, verifying service quality or safety, and performing any of the other actions or activities allowed under this Privacy Policy;

- Social media platforms and networks such as Facebook, Google, Twitter, Pinterest, and Instagram that offer functionalities, plugins, widgets, or tools in connection with our Site (e.g., to log into an account, or to share inspiration, finds, purchases, and other content with your friends and followers on social media). We also may share personal information with third parties upon your request or with your approval, though we may not be able to accommodate all requests. Finally, we may also share aggregated and/or anonymized data with others for their own uses.

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties your personal information, outside of the situations detailed above, unless you consent otherwise. Our ability to use the information, and share it as outlined in Sections VII and VIII, is controlled by your consent, or by contract if you have created an account, to the terms of this Privacy Policy, which you may choose to withdraw at any time.

Section IX. Security, Protection and Storage of Your Personal Data

We take the security of your personal information seriously and use reasonable electronic, personnel and physical measures to protect information from loss, theft, alteration, or misuse. However, in general, information transmitted over the Internet, including blockchain technology, may not be entirely secure, and thus we cannot assure the absolute security of your personal information. Please be advised that even the best security measures cannot fully eliminate all risks. We cannot guarantee that only authorized persons will access your information. We are not responsible for third-party circumvention of any privacy settings or security measures.

Wherever we or a trusted third-party service collects sensitive information (such as credit card data), that information is encrypted and transmitted in a secure way. You can verify this by looking for a closed lock icon at the bottom of your web browser or looking for "https" at the beginning of the website address, also known as a URL, of the web page. When you execute a transaction at our establishment using a credit card, our payment processor securely handles your credit card data, ensuring it is encrypted through PCI-DSS compliance. Subsequently, the transaction information is promptly deleted once deemed unnecessary. We uphold strict standards and never transmit sensitive financial details via email. We encourage you to take steps to help protect the confidentiality and security of your account and personal information, including by doing the following:

- Reviewing your account periodically and immediately reporting any unexpected activity or unrecognized information;
- Installing the latest security updates and anti-virus software on your computer to help prevent malware and viruses;

- Signing out/logging off of website sessions so that your session is closed, especially when using a public computer.

We are dedicated to protecting all personal information as is necessary. However, you are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of your personal information by keeping your password confidential. Section XII. Notices, Disclosures, and Jurisdiction – Specific Rights

- Links to Other Websites and Services. Our Site may provide links to other Internet sites, content, or videos (embedded or direct links) maintained by third parties. We are not responsible for the sites, content, or videos accessed via the links and we have not reviewed the privacy practices of those third parties. We encourage you to review the privacy practices of those third parties.
- Browsers Do Not Track Signals. While we strive to offer you choices when you use our Site and Services, we do not promise that we will be able to receive or honour web browser Do Not Track signals.
- International Customers. If you provide personal information through our Site, you agree that the personal information will be transferred to and processed in the United Kingdom, the EEA and any other country or jurisdiction at our sole discretion. The laws that apply to the use and protection of personal information in the United Kingdom, EEA or other countries or jurisdictions in which we transfer or process personal information may be different than the laws and protections in your own country. As a result, your information may be processed in a foreign country where privacy laws may be less stringent than the laws in your country. - Provide you with a different level or quality of products or Services.
- Suggest that you will receive a different price or rate for products or Services or a different level or quality of products or Services.
